LANDSCAPE CONCEPT


This landscape has been designed to attract Bees, Butterflies and birds into the gardens, and includes edible berries for human use.


A 2- rail fence is placed along property lines to create a sense of private space, to protect the gardens, and to discourage non-residents from walking through the property.




CIRCLE BIKE RACK












